CMSA provides great learning opportunities for high school and college students through our paid internship program. The internship program has a minimum commitment of 20 hours/week, for a minimum of 6 weeks, and cannot exceed 960 hours in a calendar year.

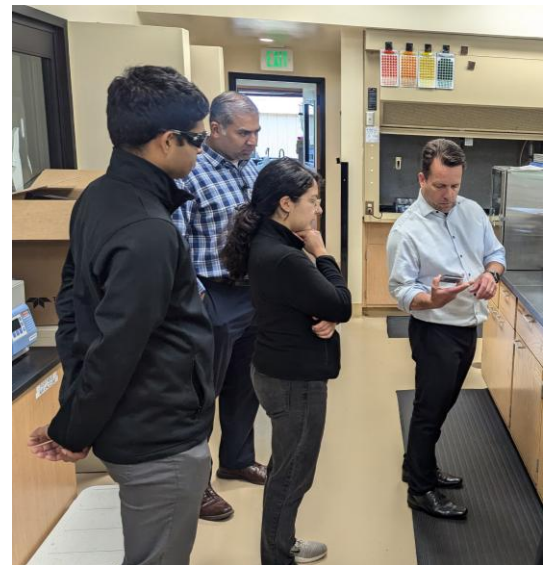
We offer a variety of internships in the following departments:

- Engineering Design and Construction Management
- Laboratory Analyst
- Treatment Plant Operations

Interns may be hired into a specific department, with the opportunity to work with other departments. We provide our interns with opportunities to cross-train within our agency to allow a full understanding of what a wastewater agency does. Our goal is for interns to develop their interests in the industry, gain knowledge on wastewater treatment, and receive the best resources possible to succeed in the next phase of their professional career.

Criteria

- Applicants may be currently enrolled in a Marin County high school or currently enrolled in a college undergraduate or graduate degree, Career Technical Education (CTE), Regional Occupational Program (ROP), or similar program. Students under 18 years old must have a Work Permit issued by the school where the student is enrolled.
- Applicants should commit to minimum duration of 20 hours/ week for a minimum of 6 weeks

Technical Services Internships & Student Work Opportunities

- Applicants may be currently enrolled in a Marin County high school, or currently enrolled in a college undergraduate or graduate degree, Career Technical Education (CTE), Regional Occupational Program (ROP), or similar program.
- Minimum commitment of 20 hours/week, for a minimum of 6 weeks
- Internships cannot exceed 960 hours in a calendar year.
- Students under 18 years old must have a Work Permit issued by the school where the student is enrolled.
- Rate: \$18-26 per hour, depending on qualifications
